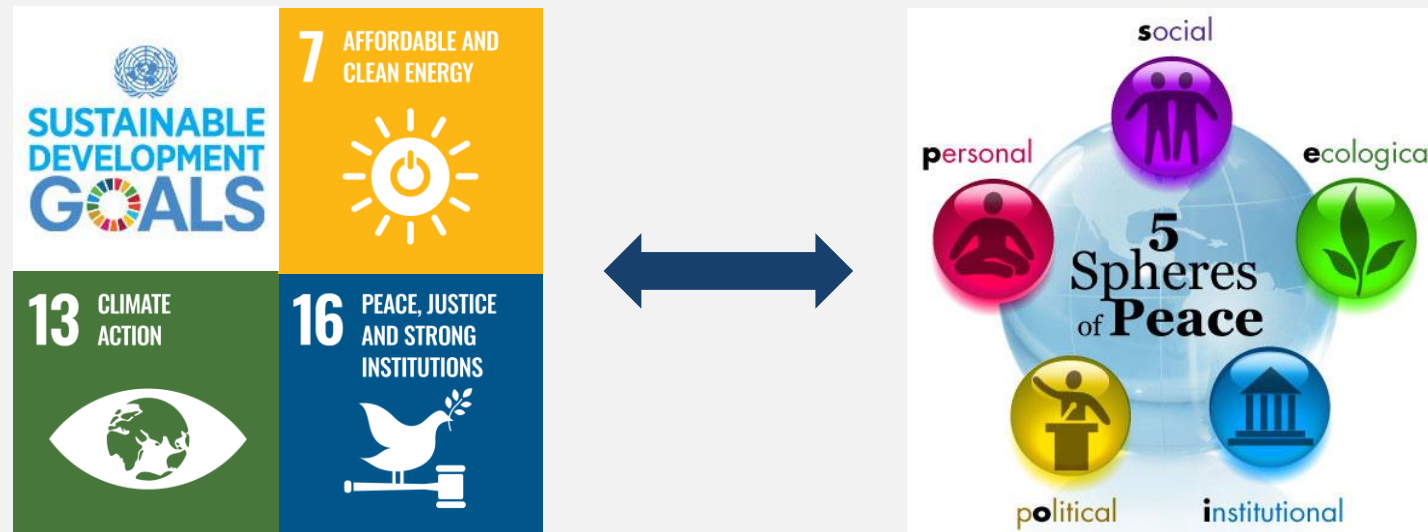


POLITICAL UNITY – CLIMATE CHANGE
